Please note, on Kol Nidre (Tuesday, Oct 11), the sanctuary doors will be closed beginning at 6:00pm. There will be **no admittance** into the sanctuary during the Kol Nidre recitation. Once the recitation is over, the doors will be reopened for seating.

The sanctuary temperature is set for 68 degrees during High Holy Day services, and the back of the sanctuary is cooler than the front. Please dress appropriately.
