## Tallitot/Kippot (Yarmulkes)

A limited number of tallitot will be available in the lobby. We ask that you bring a personal tallit if you have one. You may leave your personal tallit in our coat room after Kol Nidre services for use on Yom Kippur day. Men, and boys who had their Bar Mitzvah, are required to wear kippot and tallitot at all services; women are encouraged to wear kippot and tallitot.

## Sanctuary Temperature

The sanctuary temperature is set for 68 degrees during High Holy Day services, and the back of the sanctuary is cooler than the front. Please dress appropriately.
